

## Charter of individual commitment for a safe stay in a mountain gite/shelter

In the health context of COVID-19, individual responsibility for limiting the effects of the pandemic is fundamental. This is also the case in the mountains, especially in mountain gites and shelters. The guards and shelter owners have adapted the organisation and operation of the shelters to welcome you in the best possible conditions. **It is essential that everyone respects the measures and protocols put in place.**

This is why, to confirm my **obligatory reservation** of my stay in this type of accommodation,

### **I hereby certify:**

- To be aware that in the current health context, the functioning, the reception conditions and the services offered by the shelter will not be the same as usual;
- To be aware of the specific equipment that **I must bring** for myself and my group, for our stay:
  - o At the Piton des Neiges **shelter** or the Roche Ecrite shelter (individual protection and disinfection equipment, duvet, personal linen and towels ...).
  - o At the other **mountain gites on Reunion Island** (individual protection and disinfection equipment, duvet or sleeping bag (recommended), personal linen and towels,...).
- Be aware that failure to respect the health regulations may lead to the cancellation of my reservation by the person in charge at the shelter, in order to ensure the safety of others in the face of the epidemic.

### **I also certify the following:**

- Not to go to the gite/shelter if someone in my group or myself should experience potential symptoms of COVID-19 (cough, fever >37.8°C, diarrhoea, nausea, cold, extreme fatigue, conjunctivitis, loss of taste or smell);
- To respect the conditions of my reservation (number of people, composition of the group, number of nights, type of service (private room or dormitory, arrival and meal times...));
- To wash my hands with soap or hand sanitiser before entering the gite/shelter;
- To respect the social distancing guidelines (keeping a physical distance, disinfecting hands, wearing a mask, respecting the directions when moving around the buildings, ...) and the internal regulations which have been adapted to each gite/shelter, and presented in the specific health protocol available on the website en.reunion.fr;
- To bring all the adequate material necessary for the health and safety of my group and for myself (hand sanitiser, mask...), in addition to the standard material necessary to ensure my safety in the mountains;
- When I leave the refuge, to deal with all the equipment used during my stay, and especially the disposable protective items used on my bed.
